1. All current financial obligations to Lovett must be met before students will be allowed to participate in optional trips. Please contact the business office or financial aid office with questions or to verify your status.
2. Students will travel to and from Siempre Verde as a group.
3. Students will be responsible for the cost of flights, visa fees (if applicable), travel insurance, hotel fees, local transport, tourist fees, tips, and food. Additional costs may arise.
4. All prepaid costs will be charged to student accounts.
5. For many Lovett trips, interest exceeds the number of available spots. Thus, a completed application does not imply that the student has a confirmed place on the trip. Trip leaders will notify all students who apply to confirm their placement on the trip or on the waiting list.

Limited financial aid may be available. Contact Steve Brown (steve.brown@lovett.org) for information.

Completed applications are due to Director of Siempre Verde, Alex Reynolds by September 28th, 2018 to ensure placement in student's first choice course. Students should indicate an alternate choice for their coursework. This is not binding, but provides expected registration numbers for each course. Online registration and payment must be completed in the spring through CamperReg.

Expected total cost is approximately \$3500, however applications received after March 1st will be charged \$4000. A \$1000 per person deposit will be added to the Lovett statement for confirmed participants upon successful online registration through the CamperReg website. This deposit will be non-refundable, unless specifically approved by the program director, Alex Reynolds. Any remaining balance will be billed in April 2019.

Signing this application signifies acknowledgement of the above parameters for the trip and understanding of the costs involved and serves as approval to charge the student account for all confirmed participants. Dates, specific activities, and costs are subject to change.

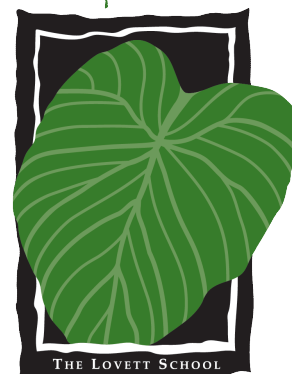

- Cost: Early registration: \$3,500 (until March 1st)
Late registration: \$4,000 (after March 1st)
- Includes: All airfare and taxes on Delta (from Atlanta) and ground transportation; hotel stays in Quito and Otavalo; meals and lodging at Siempre Verde
- Does Not Include: Tips (\$50 for Siempre Verde staff and bus driver) and purchases in the Otavalo Market (personal discretion)
- Travel Requirements: Current passport **valid for 6 months** after return trip. Parents are encouraged to review the State Department website (www.state.gov/travel) for warnings, alerts, and recommendations.
- Medical Requirements: Up-to-date tetanus booster shot is required. Additional vaccinations may be required pending itinerary. Consult CDC website for information. Moderate to strenuous hiking should be expected. Participants should be in good physical condition.
